

Majolica Tile

The Church of San Donato, Italy c.1615

There is a little building in the Abruzzi mountains of Italy close to the town of Castelli that is the majolica equal to the Sistine Chapel, the building is the church of San Donato. These magnificent & unique tiles, 810 in all, depicting coats of arms, heraldic emblems, male & female images, plants, animals & sacred images form the ceiling of the church and are dated 1615-16. We are proud to replicate this unique & priceless Renaissance art form. To do justice to this magnificent artwork we have created a tile that mimics masonry that is hundreds of years old. Each tile is made by hand, dated and carries the E seal of our company.






